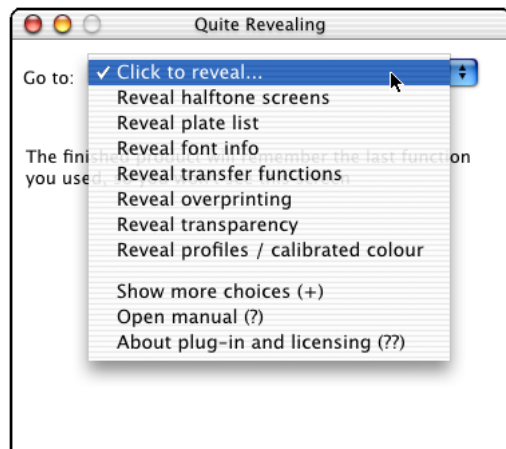


Quite Revealing

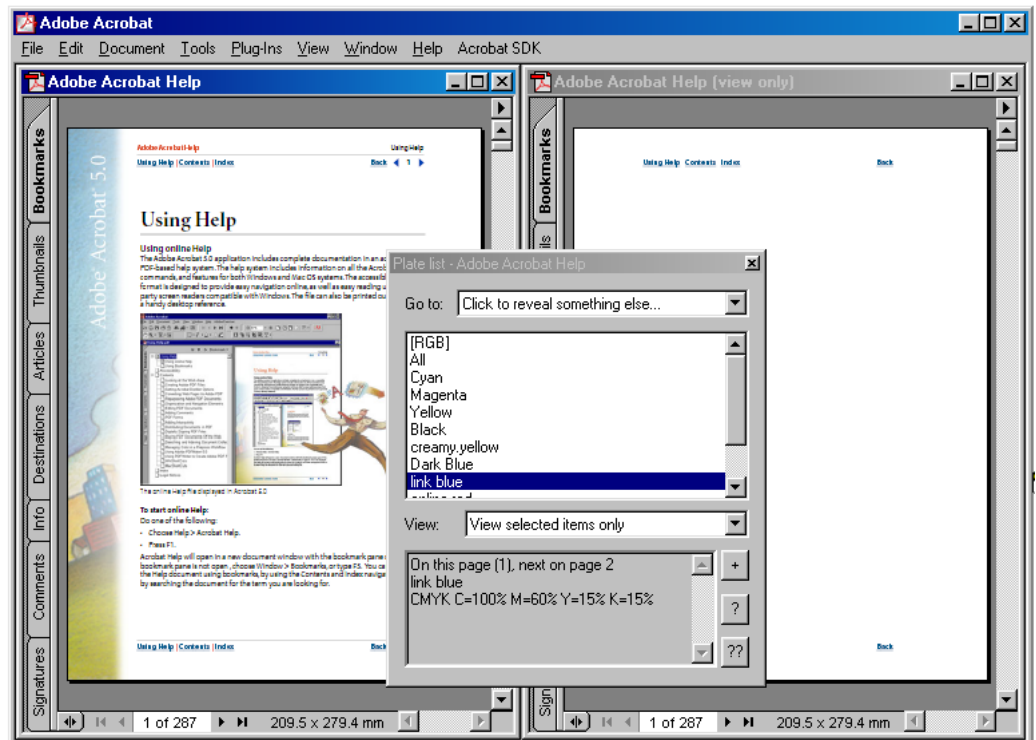
Quite Revealing is an Adobe® Acrobat® plug-in. It works with full Acrobat 4.0 or 5.0, but not with the free Acrobat Reader.

When you start it you will be able to simply choose what information you want to see. (These shots are from a beta product, and liable to change). All functions are only one click away from this control centre.

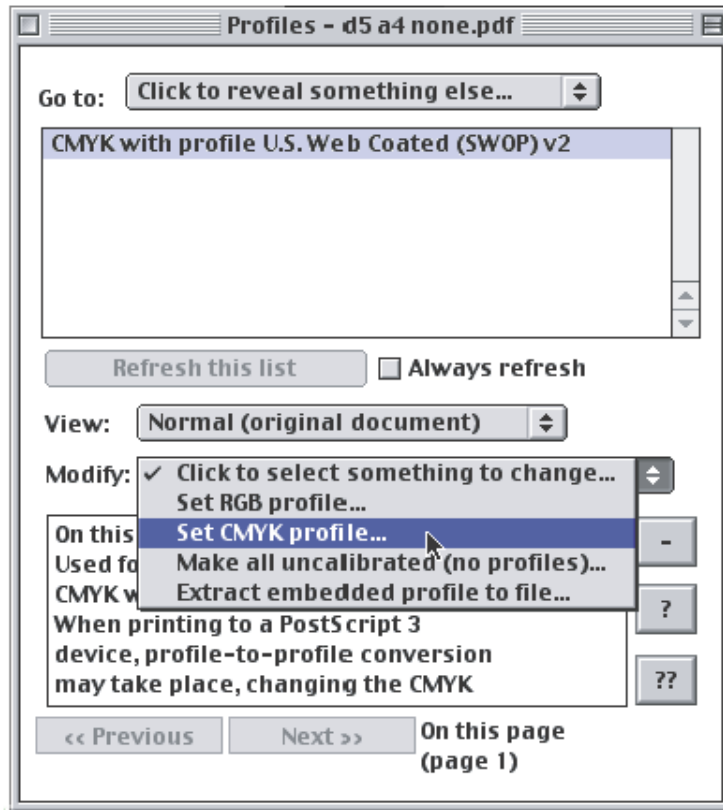

In each view, you'll see a list of the items in the file. Here it is the RGB, process, and spot plates.

You can see side-by-side a live view of the document. Zoom, scroll or edit and the view will follow.

Each type of view can have suitable actions. This is the view of embedded profiles. You can set, remove, or export profiles..

Other actions include: rename, recolour, or merge spot plates; spot plate to process; remove or apply transfer functions; remove halftone; remove transparency effects..

All actions apply to the whole document, most with just one button click..
